Pentecost Sunday

We observe the Feast of Pentecost, Green Sunday, which commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the Mother of God. It is typically referred to as "Green Sunday" since it is the custom to decorating the church and homes with green branches to symbolize the renewal of our lives and the gift of new life through the Holy Spirit.

We celebrate the great feast of Pentecost, 50 days after the Resurrection. This day is also known as the Birthday of the church. It is a solemn feast which celebrated Gods act of sending the Holy Spirit into our world. His spirit is that which makes possible: Truth, Goodness, Compassion, Acceptance, Peace, Kindness and LOVE.

The Hand of God

A man who had just converted to Christianity asked his spiritual Father how he was supposed to keep all the promises he made at Baptism. "How does any Christian stay on the straight path during life," he asked.
